THANKSGIVING FOR BAPTISM

Leader: Blessed be the holy Trinity, + one God, the fountain of living water, the Lord of life who gave us birth, our light and our salvation. **People: Amen.**

People of God, in the baptismal waters we travel with Christ from death to life. When we confess our sins, we come before a merciful and just God who forgives our sins and cleanses us from all unrighteousness. The water of life washes over us and the Holy Spirit rushes in to build in us new life. To receive this gift of renewal, let us confess together. (kneel/sit)

Holy God, we long to be your new creation. Yet, even in knowing that your Son Jesus died and was raised from the dead, we act like the world is the same. Surrounded by the haze of sin, we cannot see the new day of your reign, and we stay our same selves - the old Adam and the old Eve. Forgive us, wash us clean, and renew us for life as your Easter people.

During this Easter season, we celebrate that Almighty God raised his Son Jesus from the dead. In the waters of baptism, we are made a new creation, and one day we will experience the full resurrected life in our Lord Jesus Christ.

You, O God, give us new life.

The Spirit lives and moves through us now, a great and joyful mystery, so we may bring love and mercy into the world as the body of Christ.



READING 1 Corinthians 2:10-13 NIV (sit) The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. For who knows a person's thoughts except their own spirit within them? In the same way no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us. This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words.

HOLY GOSPEL TA John 16:7-15 G

SPEL The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the 16th chapter (v7-v15) **:7-15 Glory to you, O Lord**

NIV But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: about sin, because people do not believe in me; about righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; and about judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.

"I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you. All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what he will make known to you."

SERMON



HYMN OF THE DAY Holy Spirit, Truth Divine (stand)



NICENE CREED We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven; by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the virgin Mary, and was made man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.


Into your hands, O Lord, we commend all for whom we pray, trusting in your mercy; through your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**






OFFERING PRAYER Let us pray. Merciful Father,



of me.



COMMUNION MUSIC Eye Has Not Seen




- When pain and sorrow weigh us down, be near to us, O Lord; forgive the weakness of our faith, and bear us up within your peaceful word.
