CONFESSION & ABSOLUTION

Leader: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **People: Amen.**

Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy name, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.


If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

SILENT REFLECTION & SELF-EXAMINATION (kneel/sit) *Most merciful God,*



Leader: Gathered in peace, gathered in peace let us pray to the Lord. Lord, have mercy...




Leader: For peace from above, and for the saving power of God, let us pray. Christ, have mercy...


APOSTLES CREED I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.


