Foot Washing is a practice dating back to the Old Testament where typically slaves, the lowliest of servants, washed the feet of guests coming into the house.

At the Last Supper, Jesus scandalized his disciples by taking a basin of water and a towel to wash their feet. They wouldn't have it, but he insisted, telling them, "As I have washed your feet, you should wash one another's feet." It is an act of humility and service to one another.

Today, throughout the morning, Pastor Ryan will be in the Upper Commons in the alcove near the men's restroom to practice this act of love and service by washing the feet of others. You are invited to join him anytime on this Palm Sunday.




