- I. The test of all tests!
  - A. Tests are part of the human experience
  - B. Tests of faith
  - C. Abraham's test...a disturbing and horrifying request.
- II. The altar of sacrifice
  - A. We all sacrifice something
    - i. Time for money
    - ii. Relationships for success
    - iii. Integrity for comfort
    - B. The question is not if we are making sacrifices, but what are we sacrificing—and to whom.
- III. Genesis 22: "Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains that I shall show you." (Genesis 22:2)
  - A. Shocking!
  - B. All we see is obedience.
  - C. Isaac notices.
  - D. Abraham says "God will provide."
